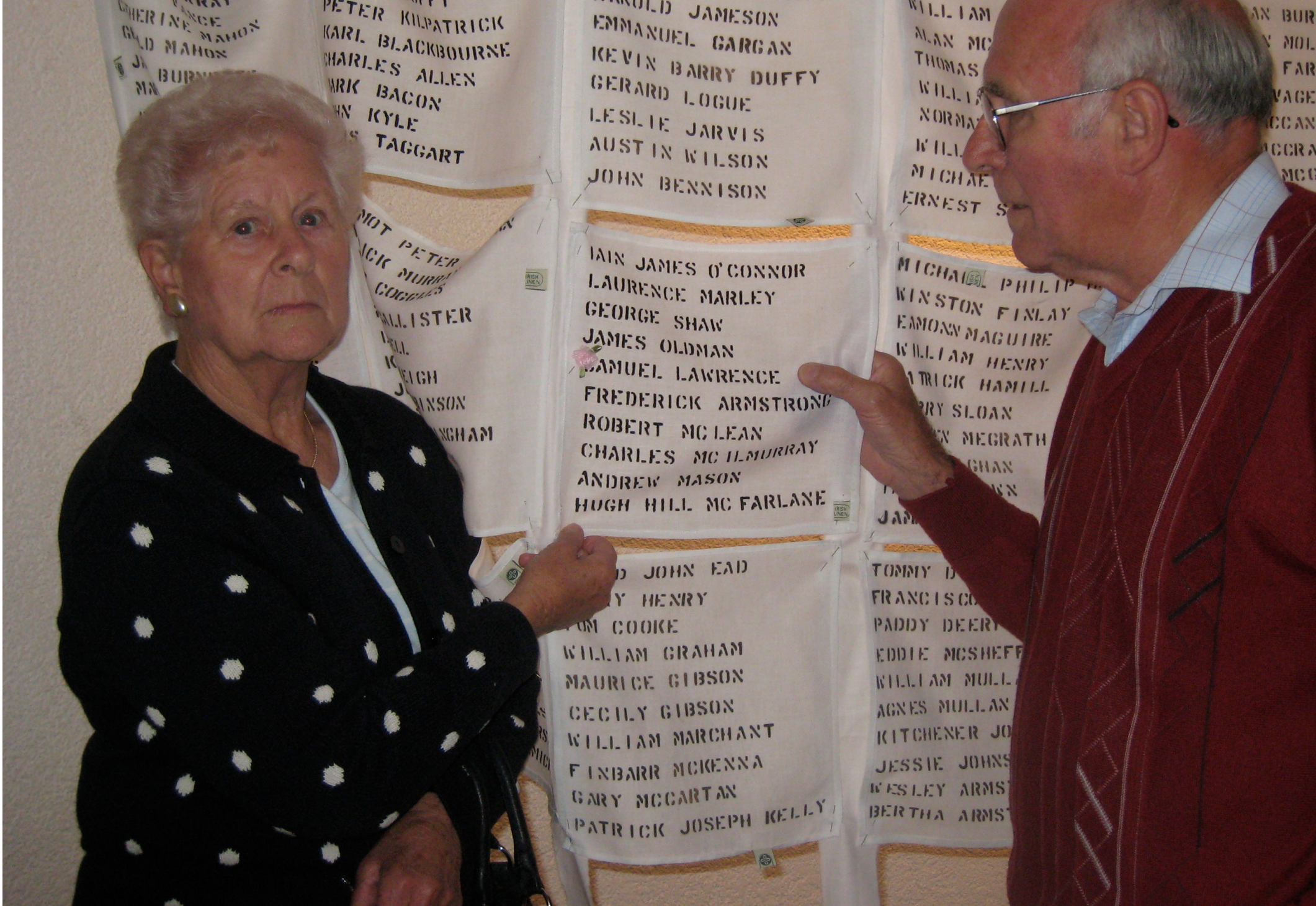

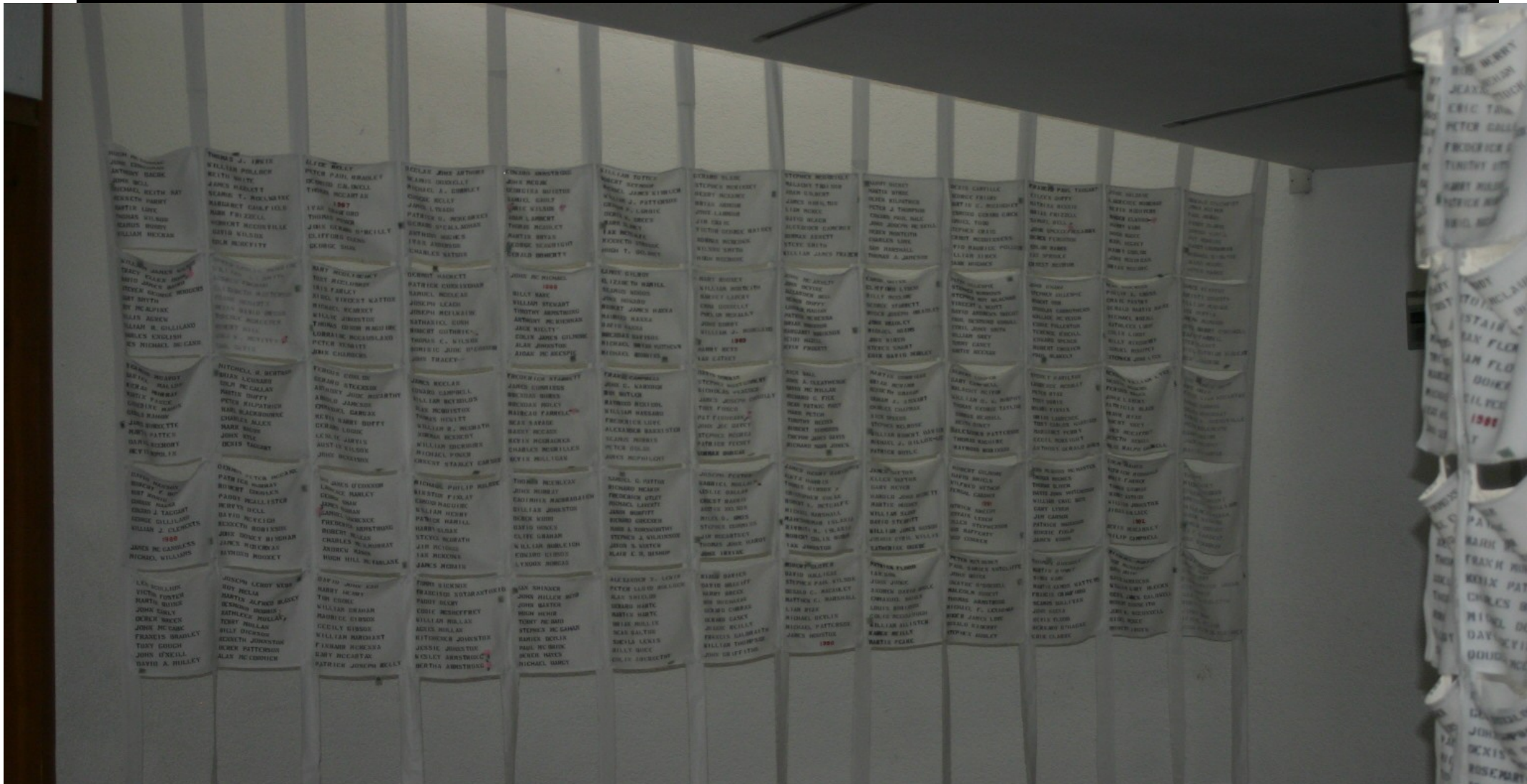

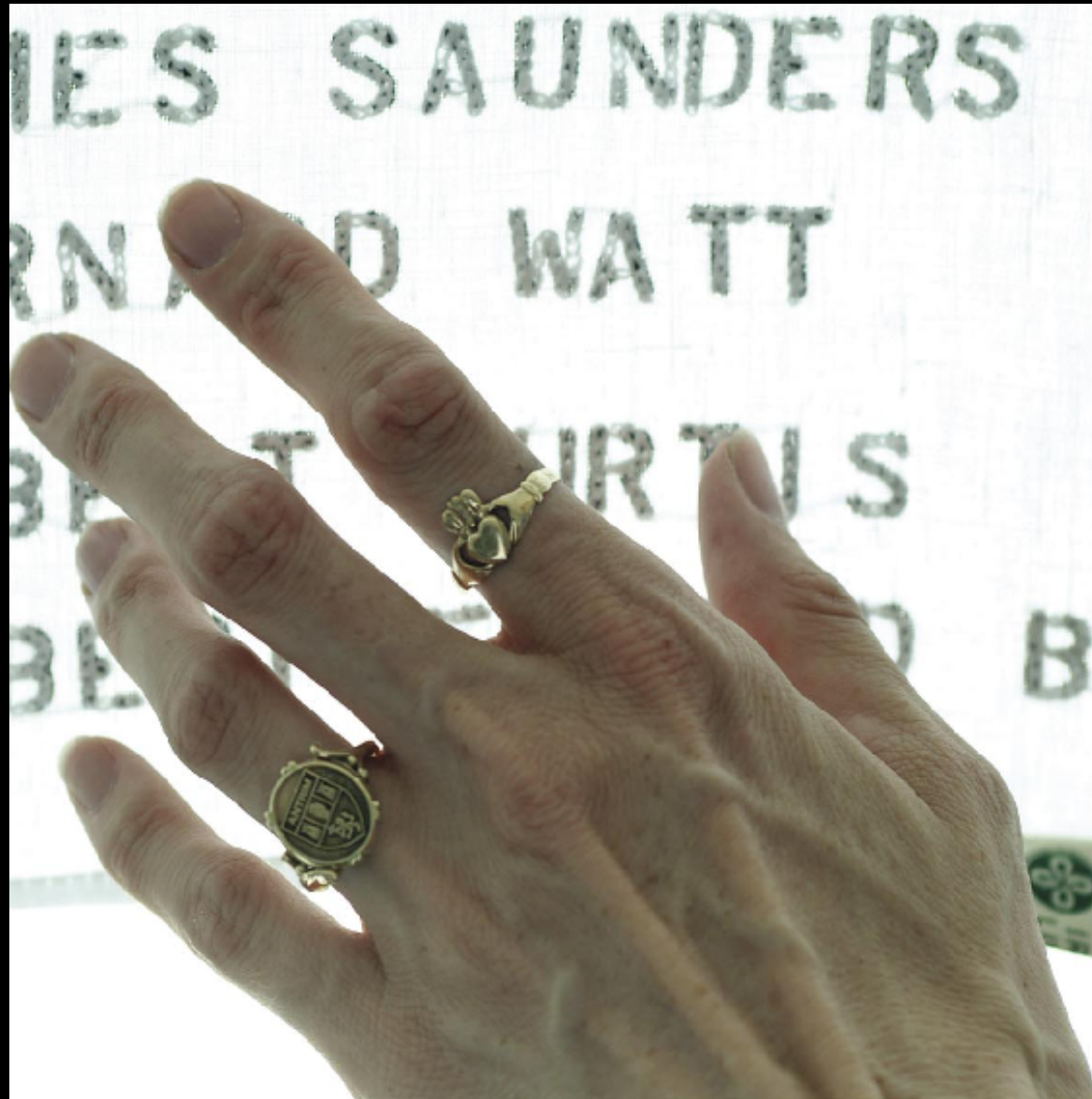


Mourners – The (Irish) Linen Memorial on the Day of (Private) Reflection, 2008

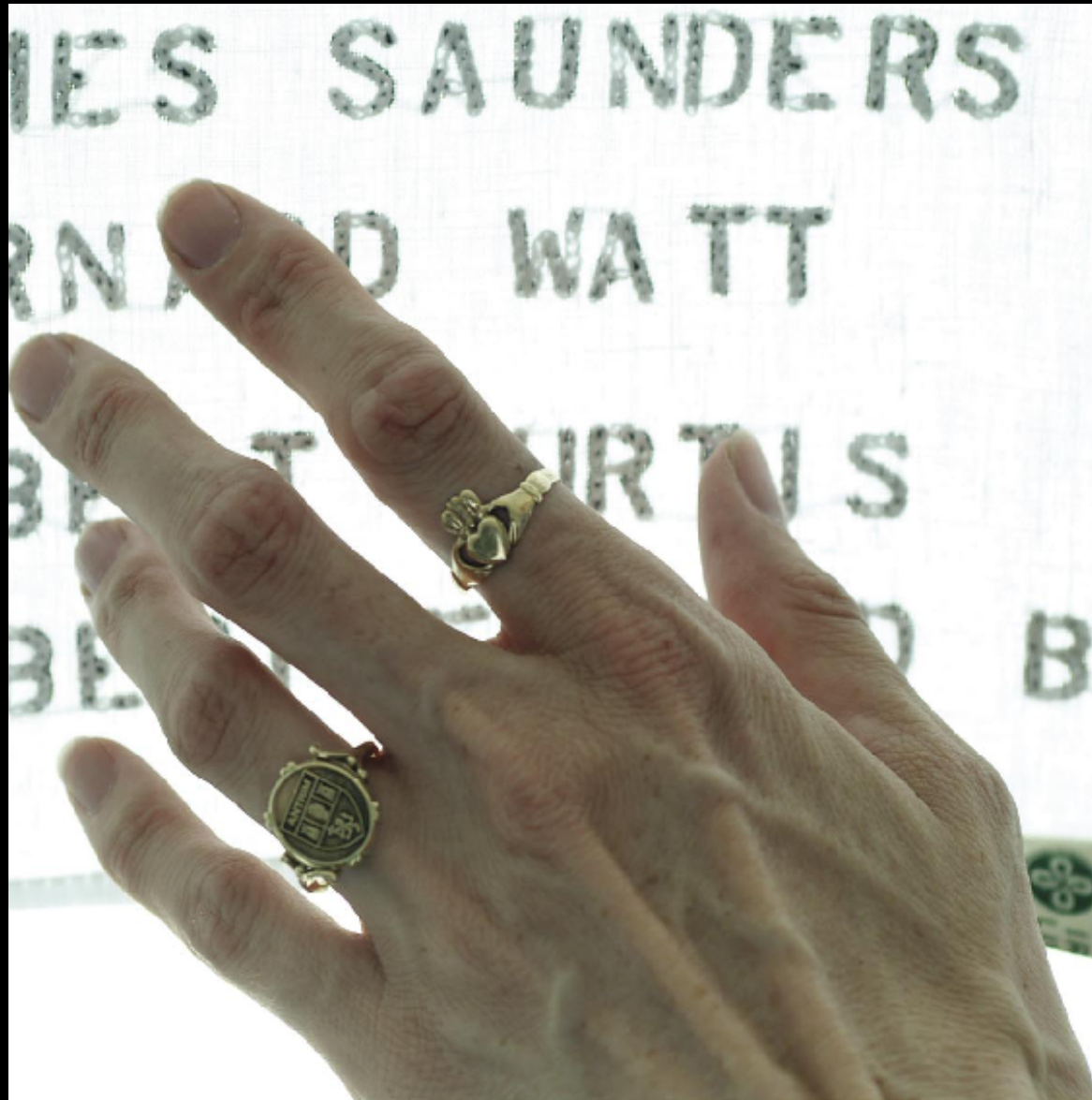


The (Irish) Linen Memorial (created 2001) includes ALL the names of those killed as a result of the Northern Ireland Troubles, from 1966 to 2008.

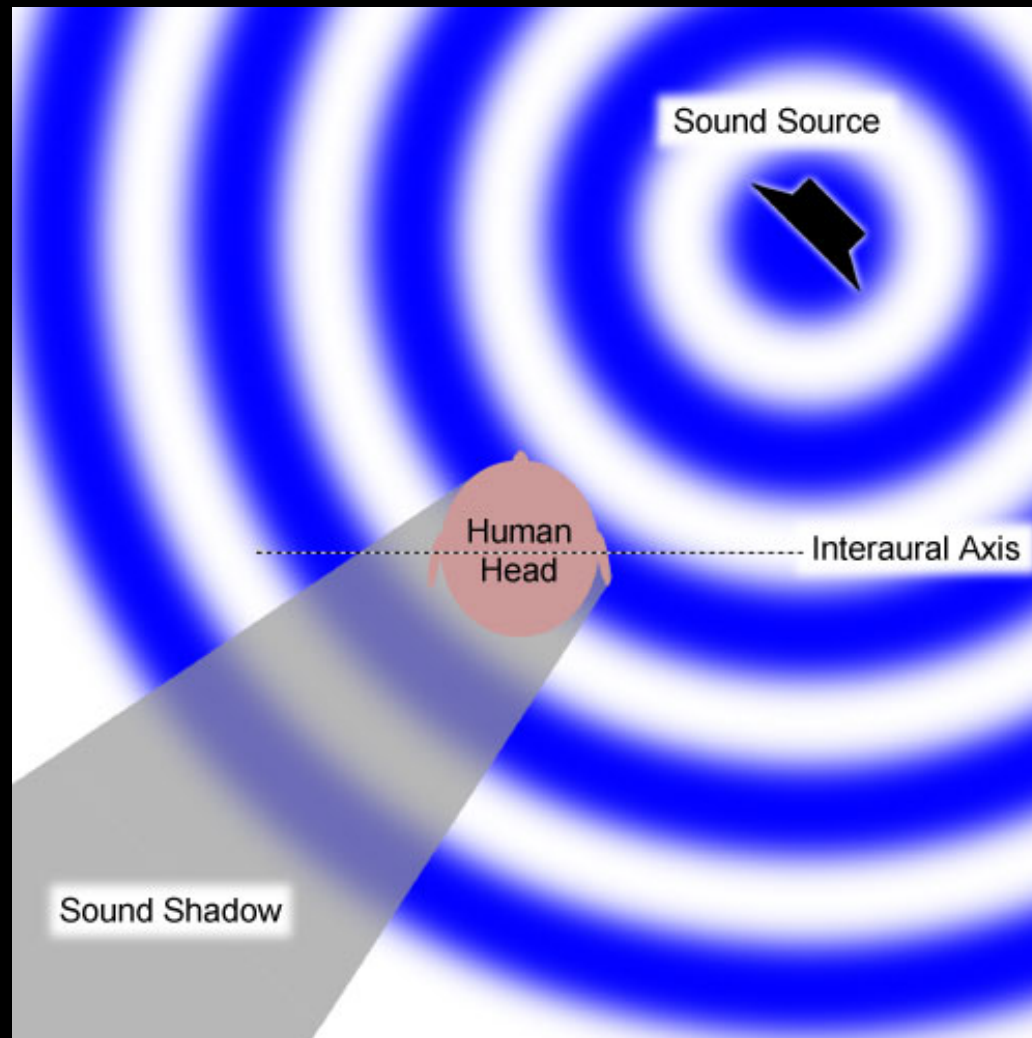
This form of ‘joint public mourning’ commemoration of all persons in a non-hierarchical and non-heroic genre may be upsetting to some.
